V. CAUSAL FACTOR ANALYSIS AND MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local AMRTs are tasked with completing a causal factor analysis and provide management recommendations associated with each population or habitat trigger. The results from this process are provided below in a *Causal Factor* table for each Conservation Planning Area. SETT staff levels were insufficient to follow up on each recommendation given in 2019, a selection of recommendations were chosen and a progress update is included in the table.
