A. On April 8, 2014, the US Fish and Wildlife Service announced a 60-day extension of the comment period on their proposed decisions, which include listing the bird as a threatened species, designating approximately 1.86 million acres of critical habitat for the species, and a special rule that would provide increased flexibility for land management practices that are intended to benefit the Bi-state sage-grouse. The extended comment period closes on June 9, 2014. The Council will discuss the proposals and may provide direction to staff on commenting on the FWS proposals – Sagebrush *Ecosystem Technical Team.*
