2021 CCS Highlights To Date

In total since inception of the program, 16 mitigation transactions have been finalized using the CCS.

Six mitigation transactions were finalized using the CCS in early 2021.

These six transactions account for 279 credits and encompass 1,434 acres of high value sagegrouse habitats which will be conserved for a minimum of 30 years.

Four credit project proponents are near completion of their CCS management plans that conserve more than 19,000 acres with nearly 6,500 credits anticipated.

Additionally, four other credit project proponents are in the initial stages of developing their management plans. These will also account for ~18,000 acres and ~6,000 credits.

The SETT expects to visit at least six projects in 2021 as part of the Five-Year Qualitative Assessments. They will also assist credit producers in planning conservation treatments.

To date, 17 debit projects representing various industries used the HQT to quantify their debits and 11 potential debit project proponents will use the HQT in 2021.
