In re: Conservation Framework Agreement

Dear CFA Signatories:

Beginning in July of 2019, Nevada Gold Mines LLC (NGM) assumed control and ownership of the majority of assets and agreements previously held by Barrick and Newmont in Nevada. These agreements included the Conservation Framework Agreement (CFA) and the Barrick Bank Enabling Agreement (BEA). Both agreements were intended to produce a Net Conservation Gain for Greater Sage-grouse and offset the impacts from mining projects.

NGM is committed to offsetting mining impacts in sagebrush habitat via these agreements and using the Nevada Conservation Credit System (CCS) and The Nature Conservancy's (TNC) Landscape Conservation Forecasting methodology. Both the BEA and CFA allow for credits and debits to be calculated using either the CCS or TNC tools. NGM's predecessor, Newmont, entered into the CFA before the Nevada CCS program was finalized and before the promulgation of the associated regulations in NAC 232. NGM has entered four credit projects into the CCS program to date, and intends to maintain these credits and the associated financial assurances.

Due to the overlapping nature of these agreements, NGM would like to respectfully request to terminate the CFA in accordance with Section XI, C, 2a. of the agreement and engage in discussion with the

signatories to expand the BEA to broaden the geographic area and enhance the participation of State agency partners in NGM's sagebrush ecosystem conservation efforts.
