Update

- The development of the Summit Lake Project as a CCS public lands Credit Project, in collaboration with NDOW, has been paused
 - Based on feedback received at June 3, 2025 SEC meeting
 - Desire of the council for us to continue analyzing potential projects within closer proximity to Greenlink North
 - Contacted various agencies and counties with only a handful of shapefiles returned that have generated minimal credit amounts









Update

- Continuing efforts that were initiated in January 2025 to find potential public lands projects feasible for the Greenlink North Transmission Project
 - SETT has conducted meetings with several partners to discuss possibilities
 - Phase III removal as an approved public lands project type has allowed more possibilities
 - E.g., Dec 2024: began discussions with USFS about potential collaboration on PJ/fuelwood removal projects
 - With addition of Phase III, there may be a potential good-fit for GLN near Ruby Lake NWR (will need to further analyze)









Update

- Challenging to find project options that will:
 - Have net conservation gain for GRSG
 - That will create <u>contiguous</u> areas of GRSG habitat
 - That will offset Greenlink North's remaining debit obligation
