Reasoning

 On October 30, 2019, the Sagebrush Ecosystem Council passed regulations that required the use of the Conservation Credit System for any mitigation regarding impacts to Greater Sage-Grouse.

• Since then, the number of projects coming through the Program has exponentially increased.









Reasoning

- Debit Proponents have requested to have a mechanism to allow the collection of a set cost for small credit amounts (e.g. <10) to be compiled to fund a bigger, more impactful project
 - Not many landowners like to sell a handful of credits at a time
 - Removes the bulk of the paperwork for small transactions for landowners, debit producers, and SETT staff
- Add in a penalty structure to ensure Debit Project compliance with NAC 232.400 – 232.480.
 - Have had 3 non-compliance issues
- Charge fees for doing work for a proponent that a Verifier can be hired to do
 - 100% HSI
 - Public Lands Mitigation









NRS 232.161 Account to Restore the Sagebrush Ecosystem: Creation; duties of Director; limitations on use of money in Account.

- 1. The Account to Restore the Sagebrush Ecosystem is hereby created in the State General Fund. The Director shall administer the Account in a manner consistent with policies and priorities established by the Sagebrush Ecosystem Council created by NRS 232.162.
- 2. Any money received through the following sources must be deposited into the Account:
 - *Any* The Director may apply for and accept any gift, donation, bequest, grant or other source of money applied for and accepted by the Program Manager. Any money so received must be deposited in the Account.
 - b) In-lieu fees collected pursuant to paragraph (e) of subsection 7 of NRS 321.162 to fulfill their obligation as set forth in regulation.
 - c) Penalties for non-compliance of authority pursuant to paragraph (e) of subsection 7 of NRS 321.162 collected as set forth in regulations.









NRS 232.162 Sagebrush Ecosystem Council: Creation; members; terms; vacancies; compensation; powers and duties; biannual report to Governor.

- 6. The Council may:
 - Adopt regulations to govern the management and operation of the Council;
 - b) Establish subcommittees consisting of members of the Council to assist the Council in the performance of its duties;
 - c) Establish reasonable fees and penalties related to the activities prescribed by paragraph (e) of subsection 7, and
 - d) Consider and require the recovery of costs related to activities prescribed by paragraph (d) of subsection 2 of NRS 321.594 pursuant to NRS 701.600 to 701.640, inclusive, or any other authorized method of recovering those costs.









NRS 321.594 Powers and duties of Administrator and Division regarding programs to improve sagebrush ecosystems; Division authorized to make certain grants and enter into certain contracts and agreements; regulations.

- 2. In carrying out the program described in subsection 1, the Division, on behalf of the Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, shall:...
 - (d) If requested, consult with persons proposing to conduct activities in any area which includes any *sagebrush* ecosystem habitat of the greater sage grouse (Centrocercus urophasianus) to suggest measures to avoid, minimize or mitigate the effect of the activities on any sagebrush ecosystem;
 - (e) Solicit grants and private contributions for projects to improve sagebrush ecosystems; and
 - (f) Authorize reasonable hosting expenditures for meals, beverages, and small gifts through the general fund by or on behalf of Sagebrush Ecosystem Program who is conducting business activities necessary to provide a benefit to the Sagebrush Ecosystem Program by establishing goodwill, promoting the Program, or otherwise advancing the mission of the Program; and









NRS 321.594 Powers and duties of Administrator and Division regarding programs to improve sagebrush ecosystems; Division authorized to make certain grants and enter into certain contracts and agreements; regulations.

- 2. In carrying out the program described in subsection 1, the Division, on behalf of the Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, shall:...
 - (fg) On or before August 1-June 30 of each year, submit a report to the Sagebrush Ecosystem Council created by NRS 232.162. The report must include, without limitation:...
 - (4) A description of any significant activities conducted in any area which includes sagebrush ecosystem habitat of the greater sage grouse and all measures adopted to avoid, minimize or mitigate the effect of the activities on any sagebrush ecosystem; and...
 - (5) The amount of money dispersed for hosting expenditures and the specific purpose and activity for which the money was expended; and
 - (56) Any other information specified by the Division or requested by the Council.
